

William A. Casto 92, Ormond Beach, FL

ORMONDBEACH, FL. - William A. Casto, 92, of Ormond Beach, Florida, passed away Saturday, September 20, 2008, following an extended illness.

He was born on November 26, 1915, in Jackson County, the son of the late Oscar O. and Leota Fields Casto.
