Van B. Miller III, 86, husband of Agnes H. Miller, died June 18, 2009, at the VA Hospital in Huntington. Mr. Miller is the son of the late Van B. Miller II and Lorie Bias Miller.

He is survived by two sons, Stephen Van B. Miller (Joyce) of Versailles, Ky., and Keith H. Miller (Gretchen) of Lawrenceburg, Ky. He leaves behind five grandchildren, Samantha, Lydia, Tyler, Chase, and Danielle; and a sister, Virginia Burgess of Cleveland, Ohio.

He was preceded in death by three sisters, Aderinne Holstein, Vesta Ferrell and Floretta Evans. Mr. Miller was a Naval World

War II veteran, a naval aviator, and a graduate of the University of Miami, Fla., Law School. He was Ashland Oil's first jet pilot, spurred the creation of Kenwood and was their first Mayor.
