"John C. and 'Sine' Akers lived for a long time on Miller's Creek in Johnson County, Kentucky; but, like John's brother, Robert W. Akers, after the advent of the Consolidation Coal Company, they sold out and moved to Whites Creek, West Virginia, and remained on their farm there the rest of their lives.

The Akers cemetery you seek, from what information I have, is located on a ridge between Sharp's Branch and Whites Creek, east of the Cyrus Baptist Church. It is an old cemetery and pretty much abandoned.

Your John C. is buried there. The tombstone gives dates of 12/22/1859 - 9/30/1934. Also buried there is his wife. The name on the tombstone is simply Lou and the dates are 1861- 1941.

Also buried there are:

Charlie Akers, 10/24/1898 - 11/6/1922

Charlie's wife was Jessie Wilson, but not buried here.

Nancy B. Akers, 8/30/1828 - 3/1/1919

Willie H. Akers, 6/30/1889 - 6/1/1811

Albert Akers, 4/25/1882 - 1/13/1930.. may be brother of John C.

Kent Akers, no dates or stone.
